

AIA E201-2007 Digital Data Protocol Exhibit—Suggested Revisions:

Transmission of Digital Data:

Article 2.2: In line 1, after “confidential and” insert “, except as required by law,”.

Article 2.5: In line 1, after “shall” insert “waive any and all claims against the transmitting party and”.

New

Article 2.6: Add, “The receiving party recognizes that data, plans, specifications, reports, documents or other information recorded on or transmitted as electronic media are subject to undetectable alteration, either intentional or unintentional due to, among other causes, transmission, conversion, media degradation, software error, or human alteration. Accordingly, the electronic documents provided to the receiving party are for informational purposes only and are not intended as an end-product or as a Contract Document. The transmitting party makes no warranties, either expressed or implied, regarding the fitness or suitability of the electronic documents.”
